Please Note: Soup Bowl registrations and bowling payments will all be online and must be complete 3/8/19. Online registration will eliminate payment lines at Kelley's, and will help us avoid empty lanes. As in the past, we will have a wait list when we fill the lanes. We will contact you if someone cancels.

You can go online and pay for 1, 2, 3, or 4 bowlers. You do not have to pay for your whole team at once. There is a space for team name and/or team captain as well as your contact information. If you register and pay in advance and cancel by March 8th, you will receive a full refund. If you cancel after that date, you will get a full refund if we can fill your spot.

If you do not want to pay online, you can pay at the Soup Kitchen office—call 925-8204 to arrange that. No bowling payments will be taken at Kelley's.

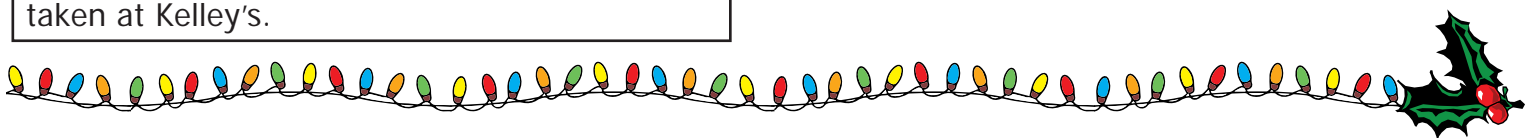

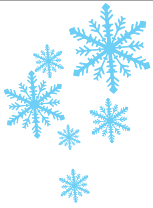


Cost of this fun fundraiser is only \$25. A small price to have fun and contribute to the only agency open every day of the year to feed our neighbors in need.

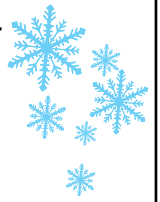
As last year, all registrations and payments will be made online and the registration deadline is January 25th. We must have your registrations before tournament day because the game requires four players per table.
